Board of Commissioners Regular Meeting, March 17, 2010

### **Campaign Contribution: Financial Disclosure Resolution Fails (Again)**

A Resolution by Darnell to require persons seeking county contributions over \$50,000 to list the dollar amount of contributions to members of the Board of Commissioners fails due to the lack of four (4) affirmative votes:

**Voting Yes:** Edwards, Darnell

**Voting No:** Riley, Boxill

**NOT Voting (but present):** Pitts, Lowe, Eaves

The Resolution was introduced at the February 17 meeting of the Board of Commissioners and failed due to the lack of four (4) affirmative votes:

**Voting YES:** Darnell, Edwards

**NOT Voting (but present):** Pitts, Eaves

**Absent:** Boxill, Lowe

### **Grady Hospital System: Residency and Quality of Care Audit Policy and Procedures Legislation held for two (2) weeks**

The (Proposed) "Standard Operating Procedures (SOP)" to be used to monitor the contract between the Grady Hospital System and Fulton County was held for two (2) weeks at the request of Commissioner John Eaves.

Developed in coordination with Grady officials, the procedures will be used to meet the requirements of the MOU as amended as follows: (1) That reimbursement shall be based upon services to eligible Fulton County residents (2) That the quality of care shall meet goals in specific areas including "patient safety" and "customer satisfaction".
