

1 **RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MANAGER AND**
2 **PURCHASING DIRECTOR TO DEVELOP ADMINISTRATIVE**
3 **REGULATIONS FOR THE DISCLOSURE OF CAMPAIGN**
4 **CONTRIBUTIONS BY ENTITIES SEEKING COUNTY CONTRACTS**
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7 **WHEREAS**, it is essential to the proper operations of Fulton County
8 Government that the business of the County be conducted in an environment
9 that is free from both actual impropriety and the appearance of impropriety; and

10 **WHEREAS**, each year, the Fulton County Board of Commissioners
11 considers and decides upon the award of contracts with private persons and
12 entities for goods and services needed for County governmental purposes; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in the aggregate, such contracts annually amount to the
14 expenditure of tens of millions of taxpayer dollars; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in the zoning context, state law (O.C.G.A. § 36-67A-1, *et*
16 *seq.*) requires both applicants for rezoning and opponents of rezoning to disclose
17 certain campaign contributions made to any local government official(s) who will
18 consider the rezoning application; and

19 **WHEREAS**, no similar state law or County ordinance presently requires
20 such disclosure in the context of County purchasing or contracting; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners finds that the public trust and
22 principles of open government will be better served by requiring the disclosure of
23 campaign contributions by persons or entities seeking contracts with Fulton
24 County;

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of
26 Commissioners hereby directs the County Manager and Purchasing Director to

1 develop, within thirty (30) days, administrative regulations to require persons and
2 entities seeking contracts through the Fulton County purchasing process to
3 disclose campaign contributions made to any current member of the Fulton
4 County Board of Commissioners.

5 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that such disclosure forms shall be
6 included in the materials provided to the Board of Commissioners in advance of
7 the Board's consideration of the procurement matter in question.

8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall become effective
9 upon adoption, and all Resolutions and parts of Resolutions in conflict with this
10 Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.
