****Applicable Codes**

290-5-14.02(1)(b) Permits are invalidated by change of permit holder, location or change in type of operation.

290-5-14.02(1)(c)2 Prior to the issuance of the permit to new or existing establishments the applicant shall provide evidence of satisfactory compliance with the provisions of this Chapter and all other provisions of laws that apply to the location, construction and maintenance of food service establishments and the safety of persons therein.

290-5-14.03(1)(a) Complying with this Code by having no violations of Risk Factor and/or Public Health Intervention provisions during the current inspection.

290-5-14.10(i)3: Failure to correct these violations to the satisfaction of the Health Authority may result in such emergency action as deemed necessary by the Health Authority including actions pursuant to O.C.G.A. 31-5-2(b);31-5-9(a).

290-5-14-.10(1)(e) If operations of a food service establishment are discontinued due to the existence of an imminent health hazard or otherwise according to law, the permit holder shall obtain approval from the Health Authority before resuming operations.

290-5-14.02(1)(a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any type of food service operation: food service establishment, mobile food service unit, extended food service unit, or temporary food service establishment, without having first obtained a valid food service permit from the Health Authority pursuant to this Chapter.

290-5-14-.03(2)(n) If an imminent health hazard exists because of an emergency such as a fire, flood, interruption of electrical or water service for two (2) or more hours, sewage malfunction, misuse of poisonous or toxic materials, onset of an apparent foodborne illness outbreak, gross unsanitary occurrence or condition, or other circumstances that may endanger public health, then operations are immediately discontinued and the Health Authority is notified.

N/A = no inspection required – operating without a permit requires immediate closure until fee payment remitted

Closed = facility closed by inspector

Voluntary Closure – owner closes on their own before inspector forces closure
