What is the role of the Library Board of Trustees in this process?

The Library Board plays a critical role in advising and making recommendations to the Board of Commissioners on library matters. For example, they will make recommendations later this year on site selection for each of the new libraries. The Library Board is not involved in the procurement process.

What is the role of the Board of Commissioners in this process?

The Board of Commissioners will approve all sites and all procurements relating to the new libraries. They will also be formally issuing the bonds that citizens authorized with their affirmative vote on the November 4, 2008 referendum.

What is the naming process for the libraries?

The names currently being used for each new library project are simply working names. Ultimately, the Board of Commissioners will approve any new names or name changes. The process begins with the community suggesting a name, a committee appointed by the Library Director (with representation from the community, the Friends of the Library, and library staff) reviewing the suggestions and making a recommendation to the Library Board. The Library Board will then make a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners.

How are the projects funded?

All of the projects in the Library's Facility Master Plan will be funded through a bond issue authorized by voters in the November 4, 2008 referendum.

How will the community be kept informed and updated on the progress of the projects?

The library's website www.afpls.org will be updated regularly as the projects begin. Also, local libraries will have information available. Library staff are also always happy to attend community meetings and provide updates.
