Population—The Adamsville/Center Hill Service Area has a population of **92,190**?

Boundaries—The boundaries of the Adamsville/Center Hill Service Areas extend from the Cobb County line on the West to West Peachtree and **Northside Drive** on the East?

Poverty—According to the U.S. Census 2000, **25%** of the Adamsville/Center Hill Service Area have incomes below the federal poverty guidelines?

Environmental Factors—The Service Areas are located near two interstate highways (I-20 and I-285) and Fulton County Municipal Airport?

Health Status

From 1997 through 2006, the Adamsville/Center Hill Service Areas represented:

- 17.1% of all cancer deaths
- 21% of all deaths due to endocrine diseases (diabetes)
- 17.3% of all deaths due to circulatory diseases (heart attack, stroke)

- **HIV Deaths 1.2% higher**
