Monday	9/28	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Tax Commissioner has requested new Estimate Sheets for the tax authorities. The Assessors will initiate and review the Estimate Sheets after the Tax Commissioner indicates the Consolidation Sheet and the 2009 receivables are balanced.</li> <li>After the Estimate Sheets have been approved, the Tax Commissioner will have completed all the tasks required to initiate the tax bill printing process.</li> </ul>
Tuesday	9/29	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The Tax Commissioner has directed IT to start the bill printing process for Atlanta. The creation of ATL parcel lists for printing is in-process. It is anticipated the first batch of 20,000 tax bills will be received at the printer this evening.</li> <li>The Tax Commissioner is making preparations for printing all tax bills to meet the 10/15/09 mail date.</li> </ul>
Wednesday	9/30	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The printing of the City of Atlanta tax bills started Tuesday evening. The Tax Commissioner's staff expressed concerns regarding the parcel counts in several tax billing lists and paused printing late Tuesday night. Consequently, only 8,000 bills were printed last night. Bill printing resumed Wednesday at 11:00am. As of 3:30pm Wednesday, approximately 22,000 of the ~160,000 City of Atlanta tax bills have been printed. DoIT staff will be onsite 24/7 to continue printing. The bills are quality assured in batches.</li> </ul>
Thursday	10/01	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Tax bill printing continues. It is anticipated that the City of Atlanta bills will be completed and delivered to the Tax Commissioner on Friday, 10/02/09. As of noon today, approximately 95,000 of 157,866 Atlanta bills have been printed.</li> </ul>
Friday	10/02	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><u>All Atlanta tax bills were delivered to the Tax Commissioner the morning of 10/02/09.</u></li> <li>Printing continues on Fulton County bills (except Sandy Springs). As of noon today, approximately 60,000 bills remain to be printed (out of 176,365).</li> <li>The city of Sandy Springs very recently advertised their millage rate. It was determined that was sufficient for the Tax Commissioner to print bills with a mail date 10/15/09. Creation</li> </ul>
